

## Camphill School Curriculum

We have a Camphill curriculum devised by previous teachers, but as the core group in most classes are from mainstream schools, we mainly use SA curricula for Special Needs children eg: the SANASE and/or SA (CAPS) Curriculum for Children with Severe Intellectual Disabilities. Each class has various levels of children, so the **curriculum is adapted to suit the needs of each individual learner.**

Most importantly, each child always has an IEP (an **Individual Educational Programme.**) These especially address the most serious needs, usually the emotional and social/behavioural needs of the pupils.

The Camphill teaching plan is always to **fulfil the needs of the whole child**, emotionally, spiritually and cognitively. We aim to fulfil each child's potential as far as possible.

All mainstream subjects are taught, with Maths, Languages and Life-Skills daily, (including content subjects), balanced with Art, Handcrafts, Music, Physical Education, Gardening etc. The senior pupils are also introduced to Occupational / Vocational Phase subjects such as Home Maintenance and Home-Management.

We believe that a child cannot learn unless they are fulfilled and well-balanced in all facets of their being, and so this is our major aim. Therefore, Camphill Children are happy children!
