

## Anniversary festival celebrates 60 years

For the last 60 years Camphill School in Hermanus has been providing education and a nurturing environment for children and young adults with special needs.

Situated in the Hemel-en-Aarde Valley, the organisation functions as a private residential and day school. Children from the wider Overstrand area attend Camphill School and are fetched and taken back home every day.

The school desperately needs the ongoing financial support of the community in order to keep their doors open.

To celebrate its 60th anniversary, a four day festival has been planned from 27 April to 30 April.

The festival launches on Freedom Day, 27 April with a formal function in the Mercury Hall starting at 10:30. Several high profile dignitaries will attend the opening event.

The highlight of the festival pro-

gramme is the anniversary banquet dinner dance at the Overstrand Municipality's Banqueting Hall. This glamorous event on Friday evening is set for 19:00 and tickets are R150 pp. So dust off your dancing shoes and evening wear and call 028 312 4949 to make sure you reserve your place.

On Sunday 29 April there will be a service at Camphill at 10:00 followed by refreshments, a cultural festival and a township tour from 13:30.
