Contribute to Night of a 1 000 Drawings

The three charities to benefit from proceeds from the Night of a 1 000 Drawings on 4 December's First Fridays Art Walk, have been announced.

They are Camphill School, RAD (Rescued Animal Drive) and Yomelelani Early Childhood Development and after-school care centre.

Although many entries have been received already, the organisers are appealing to more budding artists to release their inner creative drive and contribute a collection of A5-sized drawings, paintings or sketches.

Each of the 15 galleries in the Hermanus CBD will exhibit about 100 art works – on sale at only R100 each. Last year R60 000 was raised and shared by Hospice, Whale Coast Conservation and HEAP – a school in the Hemel-en-Aarde Valley for the children of farm workers.

Liz Coates, chairperson of Hermanus First Fridays, says the artworks can be in any medium and on any subject, as long as they are A5 sized."
